Evening Satchel

Materials: fun fur or eyelash yarn or any decorative yarn

Needles: circular and double pointed needles size 10-11 to give a gauge of 3-4 stitches per inch

Ribbon or satin roping for strap – 1 yard

Cast on 40 stitches onto circular needles.

Knit for 1 inch

Knit 2 Knit 2 together Yarn Over repeat to end

Next Row: knit, you should have 40 stitches.

Knit for 7-8 inches or as long as you want the satchel.

Decrease: You will need to change to double pointed needles when there are not enough stitches to fit on the circular needles.

Row 1: * Knit 6 Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Row 2: * Knit 5 Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Row 3: * Knit 4 Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Row 4: * Knit 3 Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Row 5: * Knit 2 Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Row 6: * Knit 1 Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Row 7: * Knit 2 together * repeat to end

Cut yarn leaving a 10 inch tail, run yarn through loops on needles and pull tight.

Decorate with a tassel at the bottom of satchel if so desired. Run ribbon through holes at the top of the satchel.
